

Each varsity rated/or major East Bay Basketball Officials Association (EBBOA) member **MUST** attend and fully participate in an approved 3-person training session during the training season (usually during the 2-3 week period of pre-season basketball scrimmages). If a member DOES NOT attend, and does not have their absence(s) approved, the member who missed will:

1. Be fined a 3-person game fee. **And**
2. Not receive any playoff games. **And**
3. Not be assigned any 3-person games.

What does this mean: EBBOA tries to schedule at least (3) three 3-person training session each basketball pre-season, including the all day 3-person training at Alameda high school, the Saturday after Thanksgiving. EBBOA executive board wants all varsity rated and/or major basketball official to attend at least (1) one of the many scheduled 3-person training. EBBOA has always pride itself with the quality of the officials assigned games; league as well as playoff contest. The executive board felt that to maintain that excellence, group training would offer the best learning atmosphere for new, intermediary and veteran 3-person officials. EBBOA operates under the principle that veteran officials pass along what they have learn to the less experienced officials. When Marcella has finalized the scheduled 3-person training scrimmages, each varsity rated/major or EBBOA member who wants to learn 3-person mechanics must sign up for one of the training sessions and attend the entire training session. Remember all who sign-up for this training and do not attend, will be sanctioned as mentioned above.
